## Milk Replacer Kid Goats Feeding Chart

## Mixing Instructions:

1. First determine the number of litres of milk to be fed.
2. Measure half of this volume as hot (47-60 degree) water.
3. To determine the amount of powder use a scale and weigh 150 g times the number of litres of milk to be fed. (eg. 20L of milk requires $20 \times 150 \mathrm{~g}$ which equals 3 kg of powder.)
4. Add this milk replacer to the hot water and mix until dissolved.
5. Add remaining water to obtain desired volume aiming for a final drinking temperature of 40 C . Re-mix prior to feeding.


| Age | Volume of Milk Solution Per Feeding | Feedings / Day |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Day 1-2 | 250 ml of colostrum | 4 |
| Day 3-14 | 300 ml increasing to 500 ml | 3 |
| Day 15-42 | 800 ml | 2 |
| Week 7 | 500 ml | 2 |
| Week 8 | 500 ml | 1 |
